All students are to complete a paper that includes and expands upon the information covered in their class presentation.

Organization of the paper is important: you will be penalized for a paper that is low on content and/or is repetitive and/or does not get to the point. You are advised to write your paper using LaTeX – in this case, a good resource you may wish to consider is Overleaf (see <a href="overleaf.com">overleaf.com</a>). If using the *IEEEtran* document class for LaTex, the paper should be approximately 6-8 pages in length, including all figures, examples and references. Note: the variation in length is primarily to allow for differences due to figures, not other content.

## **Submission Requirements:**

Your paper should be saved as a PDF and submitted electronically by creating a directory on Sandcastle containing the PDF document, and then running the script <code>submit5p01</code> from this directory.
